

# A Season of Service and Celebration

As the prayerful search and discernment process continues toward the election of a bishop coadjutor for our diocese, plans are underway for celebrating the episcopal ministry of Bishop Shaw. More details will be announced, but please save these dates and start planning with your congregation now.

**April 9-June 21, 2014:** We will mark this period as our Season of Service and Celebration in honor of Bishop Shaw's nearly 20 years of episcopal ministry, which is characterized by prophetic witness and activism for social justice and equality for all; commitment to the full inclusion of children, youth and young adults into the life of the church; and conviction that God's presence is realized in community.

## Service

**April 9 Kick-Off:** Everyone is invited to join Bishop Shaw at Episcopal City Mission's Lobby Day on April 9 at 10 a.m. to kick off this Season of Service and Celebration. Please consider planning your own service event during this season in his honor or participate in one already established (such as the Mother's Day Walk for Peace, the Walk for Hunger, Pride Parade, a community clean-up day, food pantry collections, etc.). The dream is to honor Bishop Shaw by turning out thousands of people during these weeks to do public service for God's glory.

## Gratitude

**April 27 Gratitude Sunday:** During worship services on this day, every congregation is invited to read a letter of gratitude from Bishop Shaw. Special books will also be provided to each congregation in which members can record their messages, to be presented to Bishop Shaw at the celebration on June 21.

## Celebration

**June 21 Eucharistic Celebration and Family Picnic** at Franklin Park in Boston. Everyone in the diocesan community is invited to gather for a celebration and commemoration of Bishop Shaw's ministry.

**Fund for the Second Decade:** Bishop Shaw has requested that any financial gifts made in his honor be designated for the Barbara C. Harris Camp and Conference Center's second decade, to ensure its continued vitality and long-term financial stability.
