Instructions for Nominations

- 1. Members of the Convention entitled to sign nomination papers are the following:
 - A. All bishops, priests, and deacons canonically resident in the Diocese of Massachusetts
 - B. Lay delegates elected by their parishes, and holding current certification with the Office of the Secretary of the Convention
 - C. Officers of the corporation
 - D. Lay members of the Standing Committee
 - E. Lay members of the Diocesan Council
- 2. Clerical nominees for office must be clergy persons canonically resident in the diocese.
- Nomination papers must be returned to the Convention Office by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 2, 2022. Nominations will not be accepted after that time.

- 4. Signatures must be legible, as <u>each must be verified</u>. It is suggested that the name be printed as well as signed if the signer's usual signature is of doubtful legibility. - 5. Names of nominees for various offices will appear on the ballot in random order. This is specified by the Rules for Elections.
- 6. Names of nominees for uncontested offices, or where the number of nominees is equal to the number of positions, will not appear on the ballot, but will be declared elected under the provisions of the Rules for Elections.
