Episcopal oversight and responsibilities

This Advent moves our diocesan community into a new church year marked in a very particular way by anticipation and preparation for what is yet to come. We are moving into a season of transition and change as we prepare with Bud for his retirement next November. Bud, Gayle and I, together with others, are sketching out a good road map. Not all of the specifics are worked out, and nothing is written in stone. We will travel the way ahead lightly, knowing that God will give us all that we need.

Different leadership models have served us well over different periods of our diocesan life together.

At the beginning of my episcopacy, when much was new to many of us and there wasn't yet a strong leadership team at the diocesan level, I convened a senior staff to work collaboratively with me and the bishop suffragan. More recently, with an episcopal team of three bishops, we each have taken oversight of particular deaneries and ministries, which provided a helpful division of labor for a period and has given us focus and more intimate knowledge of the diocese in parts. Now, I want to reclaim more fully my role of oversight for the whole of the diocese, and I want your bishops to be more connected to all of you in the whole. I have decided that a return to our early model—two bishops making decisions collaboratively with a senior staff and others—will be an effective way forward for us. The difference now is that we are leading from a place of experience, with the benefit of strong lay and clergy leadership at the diocesan level that we have developed over these years.

This means that we will not elect a second bishop suffragan at Bud's retirement. We will instead reallocate resources in order to hire in 2011 an archdeacon to oversee congregational development, strategic ministries that are congregationally based and issues related to congregations and clergy not in transition. Additionally, the director of congregational resources and training will be moved to permanent, full-time status. Bud will continue doing visitations during 2011 but will begin cutting back in his areas of involvement. How visitations will best be handled after that is still being worked out. We may increase the number we make on a day, and we may add summer visitations. The canon to the ordinary and the new archdeacon also will have a role to play in that schedule.

What follows is an outline of key aspects of our diocesan ministries and operations and how responsibility for their oversight will be assigned. For the purposes of this document, oversight should be understood in its broad sense; how that gets put into practice in the day-to-day will differ according to the work at hand and the individuals involved. We have discovered that many ministries no longer need a bishop directly connected to them, and those will be assigned to members of the staff. Even so, no ministry will be completely disconnected from my oversight and care.

I invite you to embrace these times of change—for our diocesan leadership and for each of the communities in which we minister—with an Advent attitude: one of hopeful anticipation and getting ready for what we know is coming but can't fully imagine. God is calling us forward. I join you with confidence and excitement as we answer that call together. Please know of my prayers, and pray for us during this transition.
